

The choice is wide, from the pick-up and high capacity versions available with soft or hard tops through to 12-seater station wagons.

As personnel carriers they can take up to 14 troops and in the cargo role typical payloads of up to 1500 kg are no problem. Furthermore they have a towing capacity of up to 3500 kg. 



The armour is good against multi hits and effective repair schemes have been validated.

because it is an excellent basis for shelters to meet today's increasingly wide-ranging requirements – from command centres to mobile workshops and from field kitchens to electronics repair units.


The Defender 130 can offer a capacity of up to 6.7 cubic metres and payloads of up to 1.3 tonnes.

RAPID REACTION VEHICLES

The Special Operations vehicle (SOV), which has been proven in service with NATO Special forces, is now joined by the new Land Rover Multi Role Combat Vehicle (MRCV).

Both vehicles are powered by a choice of the powerful, economical 2.5 TDi turbo direct injection diesel with intercooler or the legendary 3.5 V8 petrol engine.

The SOV has been specially developed to meet an increasing global need for rapid reaction, go-anywhere forces.

It has been based on the proven 110 defender chassis and is airportable for rapid deployment. It can be carried in transport aircraft such as C130 or helicopters such as CH47 or EH101. It can also be underslung by heavy or medium lift helicopters or air dropped by parachute.

The SOV has a rugged, stripped down appearance and is a most formidable, all-terrain, weapons platform. A powerful mix of 30 mm cannon, 51 mm mortar, LAW 80, 7.62 mm general purpose machine gun, 5.56 mm assault rifles and 40 mm grenade pistols – or their equivalents – can be carried for the crew of up to 6 men.

The MRCV is Land Rover's answer to the need of rapid reaction forces for a versatile weapons platform or reconnaissance vehicle which retains general service capability. Thanks to a unique modular design, this multirole








vehicle combines the outstanding all-terrain performance of the Defender, the powerful weapons capability of the SOV with adaptability to perform load carrying duties; thus optimising its deployment, utilisation and value for money.

The vehicle will be available on 90, 110 or 130 chassis and may be converted in minutes using simple hand tools to one of seven distinct vehicle configurations, including pedestal mount, milan missile mount, multipurpose ring mount, and personnel or cargo carrying.
